Local Harbotzas Torah Continues into Bein Haz'manim at Borehamwood Kollel

In keeping with the vision of its founder, Dayan Chanoch Ehrentreu, *zt"l*, *avreichim* in the Borehamwood Kollel learn strong daily *sedarim* throughout the *zeman* which are not compromised, even to share Torah locally. Normally, *harbotzas Torah* is undertaken during evenings, Fridays and Shabbosos. During the first week of Nissan, however, *avreichim* utilised some of their *bein hazmanim sedarim* to be *marbitz Torah* in Borehamwood and NW London.

On Tuesday, *avreichim* travelled to Hasmonean High School to learn *b'chavrusa* together with Year 10 students. An excited *kol Torah* rang out through the school hall as

the boys, *talmidim* of Rabbi Gary Liss, enjoyed preparing a *sugya* in *Arvei Pesachim* with the *avreichim*, before hearing an engaging *iyun shiur* delivered by Reb Eli Goldstein of the *kollel*.

Later that week, a particularly significant milestone was reached. Each evening, Rabbi Avrohom Sohn, one of the *kollel's* first *avreichim* and now a Rebbe in Torah Vo'daas, delivers a *Daf Yomi shiur* for local *baalei battim*. At *seudah shlishis*, over 70 local community members and *avreichim* joined together at the *kollel* to celebrate a *siyum hashas* for one of the *chaburah*, Michael Firestone, who started learning

Daf Yomi over seven years ago with the *Rosh HaKollel*, Rabbi Yehuda Boruch Lieberman, even before the *kollel's* inception.

On Sunday, at the *kollel's* annual Pre-Pesach Learning Programme, locals learned *b'chavrusah* together with the *avreichim*, preparing for a *shiur* on the *sugya* of leaning at the *seder* by *Rosh Chaburah* and Director of Education, Rabbi Gary Bazak. A concurrent ladies' track was inspired by a *shiur* from Rabbi Danny Kirsch, Senior Educator at Shema Bni, whilst the children's programme made tasteful Pesach crafts. Finally, participants joined together for the keynote address by Rabbi Malcolm Herman, CEO of Seed UK.
